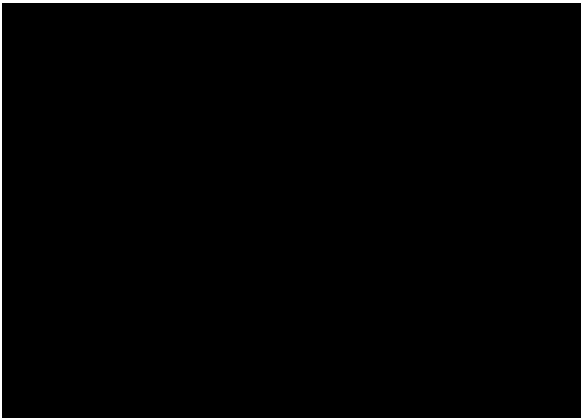


New MD Technology and Products Introduced In 2018 How Did They Fare?
